

# Beginning Landscape Quilting

## Supply List:

**Required Text:** For the **Winter Landscape**, purchase the book: **Landscape Quilts** by Natalie Sewell/Nancy Zieman.

For the **Fence Post Landscape**, purchase the book: **The Art of Landscape Quilting** by Zieman/Sewell

## Winter Landscape

1 yd of Mottled light Gray/Brown Batik/Hand Dye  
¾ yd of dark gray to black textured fabric for trees  
½ yard of textured white fabric for snow  
¼ yard of small gold leaves or gold textured fabric  
¼ yard of printed birch tree fabric

## Fence Post Landscape

1 yard of Green Batik/Hand Dye  
1 yard of bark/wood fabric for fence post  
¼ yard of 2 bark fabrics light to dark  
½ yard of large, med and small leaves for 3 different leaf groupings  
¼ yard of 2-3 green mottled fabrics for ground  
Scraps of 2-3 small scale flowers and 1 medium to large flower

## Other Supplies

32 x 40 Sheet of **foam core** (available at Hobby Lobby) for design wall  
1 ¼ yard of thermolam / batting. **Secure this to foam core with masking tape before class.**

**Serrated Edge Scissors-** 7" Clover Patchwork scissors /Ginger Eaupullete (optional) or any other very sharp scissors.

Rotary Cutter

3 ½" x 24" ruler and 6 ½" x 12" ruler

505 spray

Liquid Thread (optional)

Bonash Pressing Sheet (optional)

Scrap Piece of Batting for work area- APPROX 18 X 24

Mary Ellen's Best Press (optional)
