

Cathedral Windows with Gail Conlan

Learn to create traditional cathedral windows and secret garden squares. Then learn how to embellish them into a one-of-a-kind gift. Gail will demonstrate how simple hand sewing can create a beautiful, but looks difficult, work of art. This is a great small baggie project for people on the go.

Supply List:

Fabric – 1 yard of main fabric, small 1/8 – ¼ yard scraps (2-3) to match main fabric

Sewing needles for and sewing - I will bring an assortment, but if you have John James milliners or any type of milliner needle.

Thread – Mettler Fine, Masterpiece, or YLI silk thread in neutral or to match your fabric.

Thimble – optional

Small scissors

Stiletto

Ruler - 6 ½ “ x 6 ½” square, nothing smaller

Rotary cutter

Small cutting mat

Beads, ribbons, buttons, etc. for embellishment.
