

The Girly Girl Purse

with Joann Ewing

Materials needed:

Tammy Tadd Designs Girly Girl Pattern

1 fat quarter Upper Purse Print

Thread to match

1 fat quarter Lower Purse Print

4 Large buttons for bottom

1 fat quarter Ruffle Print

or purse feet

½ yard Lining Print

1 – 14mm Magnetic Snap (optional)

16 ½" x 24" Batting

5/8 yd Fusible Fleece

1 yd. Flat or Beaded trim of your choice

1 pair Plastic Purse Handles – 6 ¼" w. x 4 ¾" h.

4" x 9" foam core for bottom of purse (optional)

All pieces on Cutting Chart of Girly Girl Pattern, PAGE 1, need to be cut out before class time. It will take all of the class time to sew and assemble the purse. We will start at the top of page 2 in class.

You will also need to have the lining quilted before class:

Center the 15 ½" x 23" Lining Print rectangle right side up on top of the 16 ½" x 24" Batting rectangle. Quilt layers together as desired. (Using the "Edge guide" attachment, the sample was quilted with a 1" cross hatching). Trim piece to measure 14 ½" x 21 ½". Please bring all of your scraps with you and the rest of supplies listed above.

You will need your sewing machine in good working condition

Basic sewing supplies and tools, also Narrow Zipper Foot.

Mat & Rulers – 4" x 14" & 6" x 24" recommended

Chalko Liner or marking tool of choice.

Whenever possible, please purchase or order class supplies at least two weeks before the class.
