

## **Harmonic Convergence** with Michele Lyons-Russell

### **Class Description:**

From Ricky Tims' book, Convergence Quilts: Mysterious, Magical, Easy, and Fun--a fabulous vehicle for exploring the interaction of color and line; "art" quilting with a safety net!

**If you can use a rotary cutter and sew a straight line with a consistent seam allowance, you can do this!**

### **Supply List:**

- Convergence Quilts book by Ricky Tims (needed for pattern)
  
- Four squares of coordinating fabrics, as described in the Pattern 1 instructions (Please read before class.)  
These four squares need to be identical in size; that size may vary from 14" to 16"
  
- Rotary cutter (with new blade) and large mat
- 6" x 24" rotary ruler
  
- Sewing machine in good working order - cleaned, oiled if necessary
- New needle in sewing machine, preferably size 70 Schmetz Microtex Sharp.
  
- Good quality 50 wt. sewing thread in neutral color(s) for both top thread and bobbin
- Normal sewing supplies - small scissors, seam ripper, etc.
- Pins
  
- Ruby beholder/value finder (optional, but helpful)
