SUPPLY LIST

Newspaper to cover work area
Backing fabric (14 x 18)
Batting(any kind 14 x 18)
Black tulle (20 x 24) Ann has extra if you cannot find
505 spray baste (optional)
Rotary matt
Rotary cutter with new blade
Lint roller
Fabric scissors
Lots of quilting pins (straight pins)
Iron and ironing Surface (OPTIONAL – one or two per classroom is good)

FREE MOTION QUILTING SUPPLIES

Sewing machine
Needles 90/14 topstitching
Embroidery foot(darning or free-motion foot)
Mono-filament thread, clear or smoke (I use mono-poly by Superior)
Various machine embroidery threads(variegated, blues, greens, browns, gold, metallic blue)
Extension cord

FABRICS(batiks and hand-dyed work best)

Sky: 4-5 scraps of blue/white
Water: blues – 2 dark, 2 med., 2 light
Sand/ground: 6-8 white, cream, tan
Grass & tree trunk fabrics: can be printed fabric
Leaves: Greens, Lt, med. & dk. & 1 bright green
