Supply List

Sewing Machine and related supplies: scissors, seam ripper etc.

Darning foot or Quilting foot for free motion quilting and extra bobbins.

Monofilament thread

Bottom Line by Superior to match background fabric/and or back of quilt

Quilt border fabrics, binding and backing fabrics of your choosing. This can be chosen in class if desired help with adding borders is needed.

Pellon fusible fleece (available at Lakeshore) or Batting on the roll: Hobbs Heirloom fusible

505 spray

Fabric markers, decorative threads for embellishment as desired. This is added before layering.

70/10 Microtex needle and 80/12 Quilting needle for machine
