Supply List

Required Book: **“Basic Guide to Rotary Cut Quilts”**, by Fons & Porter
We will be sewing the classic “Nine Patch Baby Quilt” on page 42.
Finished quilt size @ 42” x 54”

Fabric: * **Please wash all fabric before coming to class, but do not cut. Also, please don’t choose a stripe, plaid or checker fabric for this first quilt.**

1 ¼ yards of a light fabric for blocks and setting squares.
1 ¾ yards of a dark fabric for blocks, border and binding.
1 5/8 yard of fabric for backing
45” x 60” fusible batting (purchase this from instructor)

Machine in good working order
(Practice threading and winding bobbins before coming to class)

¼” Piecing foot or Quilting foot with a guide (recommended)
75/11 Quilting needles or 70/10 Microtex Sharp needles
50 wt neutral color piecing thread (beige or gray works well)
Monopoly thread for last class session
Seam ripper, scissors, straight pins
Walking foot (recommended and useful for last session of class)
Rotary cutter (45mm recommended)
Rotary cutting mat (18” x 24” recommended)
Rulers (I suggest 6 ½” x 24”, 6 ½” x 6 ½”, 12 ½” x 12 ½”)

Whenever possible, please purchase or order class supplies at least two weeks before the class.
