SUPPLY LIST:

Newspaper to cover work area

Backing fabric (14 x 18)

Batting (any kind 14 x 18) I use cotton

Black tulle (20 x 24)

505 spray baste (optional)

Rotary matt

Rotary cutter

Fabric scissors

Lots of quilting straight pins

Lint roller

Glue stick

FREE MOTION QUILTING SUPPLIES:

Sewing machine

Needles 90/14 topstitching

Embroidery foot

Mono-filament thread clear or smoke (mono-poly by Superior works good)

Bobbin thread optional to match back of quilt.

Various machine embroidery thread (greens, black, brown, reds, purples, lt. blue)

Extension cord

Thread stand (optional)

FABRIC: batiks or hand dyes – (variety is better than quantity)

Sky: ¼ yd. or less of 4 sky fabrics

Background: ¼ yd. or less of greens (4-8 lights, 4 - 8 med.)

Stems & leaves: ¼ yd. or less of 5-8 fabrics, darks & brights (can be printed fabrics)

Flower fabrics: ¼ yd. or less of lts, med. & darks (can be printed fabrics)

Reds & purples

Ann will provide a photo to work from or bring your own photo.
