

## **Serger Decorated Tote Bag with Barbara Wright**

Come and learn how to use the different stitches your serger will do. Decorate the fabric for your tote bag and then assemble it using your serger. Yes it can be used for more than sewing stretch seams. In the first session we will use scrap fabric to learn the stitches and make your notes for future reference. The second session will be used to decorate and make the tote bag. This class will be similar to the Serging beyond the Seams Pillow offered last year.

### **Supply List**

Serger Secrets book

2/3 yard Fabric A

Fat quarter fabric B

½ yard Fabric C

½ yard fusible interfacing

1 /2 yard light weight fusible or non fusible batting

Bo Nash sheet or parchment paper or scrap fabric to keep iron clean

Approx 20 beads

3" Velcro

1 spool poly yarn or wooly nylon

1 spool heavy decorative metallic thread (i.e. Candlelight)

Serger thread to match fabric

Serger needles

Serger in good working condition

Serger manual & tools

Sewing machine in good working condition

Machine thread and needles

Basic sewing supplies (see website for list)

Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

Optional

¼" Steam a Seam
