

**Creating an Wild Woman
Art Pin
with Phyllis Duffy**

No sewing machine is necessary. Everything is done by hand. You'll leave with at least one completed pin. You will be shown how to make a "Wild Woman " pin or be given the choice of other types of art pins . Come out for a relaxing afternoon of hand stitching, beading, creating something from nothing and having fun. These pins make wonderful gifts for special friends and family.

For the body:

Six squares ea. of felt that measures 5"x5" or 1/8 yard of felt available at Lakeshore, in a color of your choice. You'll be provided with a template for the body shape.

For the Wild Woman art pin:

There will be an optional \$6.00 kit fee payable to the instructor. Kit includes pewter face, arms/legs or hand/feet, and the pin back. These kits are available on a limited basis at Lakeshore. Check ahead. I will also have some cute, hand made "face" buttons available to purchase for \$1.00 each if you would prefer to use them.

Other supplies and embellishments: most available at Lakeshore

Embroidery thread, long enough to whipstitch around the edge of the pin body.

One pair of fabric cutting scissors, med. to small.

A chalk pencil or marker (optional)

One embroidery needle.

Beading needles and beading thread . Beading needles are NOT the same as embroidery needles. I also recommend a needle threader to help with the small eye in the beading needle.

A good permanent glue, such as Fabri-tac or Gem-tac.

Pin backs, if you choose not to buy the kit.

Colored beads-all kinds and sizes. Seed beads and bugle beads are very handy .

Several 12" lengths of novelty yarn in colors of your choice.

Any interesting findings from your stash....buttons or bits of jewelry, beaded fringe or any kind of fun things to make your wild woman look wild or help you create an unusual art pin.

Note: You should be able to fit all your supplies for this class into a shoe box :-)
